Your son/daughter has shown an interest in participating in the upcoming Safe Sitter program being offered by the University Place Fire Department. Safe Sitter is a 12-hour course and your son/daughter must attend all three days in order to receive their course completion card. In order for your son/daughter to participate in this nationally recognized program you will need to register them right away.

Only 24 slots are available for this course.

SAFE SITTER is a medically accurate program that teaches boys and girls age 11 to 13 how to handle emergencies when caring for young children.

SAFE SITTERS learn:

- * What to do when a child stops breathing or chokes
- * How to call for emergency help
- * Basic child care essentials—diapering, feeding, etc.
- * How to entertain children and keep them safe

Young children cannot always communicate their needs or protect themselves. The babysitter must be able to handle whatever situation arises.
